2 Check if your personal data is in the public domain - you can use our free [Data Breach Checker](#).



1 Change your passwords - don't use birthdays or pet's names as they can easily be guessed. Try using passwordsgenerator.net



3 Contact your bank/credit card company - check there hasn't been any suspicious activity.



4 Report the breach to the ICO - this can be done on their [website](#).
